Nathaniel studied law, and in 1796 opened law offices in New York City, and there married Susannah, a sister of Dr. Samuel Bard. Washington suggested his name for Secretary of State, but the suggestion was opposed by Alexander Hamilton, who feared that he was somewhat tainted with the prejudices of Mr. Jefferson and Mr. Madison. Later he became a close personal friend to Hamilton and was his second in the famous duel, Hamilton dying in his arms. He was a delegate to the convention of 1787, which framed the Constitution of the United States, though being absent on the last day of its sessions, he failed to sign the document. He attained eminence at the bar in New York. In consequence of the strong affections of the Bard family, he, too, naturally made Hyde...
