The essay writers touch on a variety of themes from cultural landmarks to racial issues to the struggle for Civil Rights, providing the reader with a guide to important themes of the area s history and culture. The section Voices of the Delta includes interviews with nearly thirty people of different ethnicities and social classes who share their knowledge of the past and their hopes for the future.
